Guide for Parents:

The Five Finger Rule To Choosing A Book:

If you are not sure if the book is "just right" or not then try the **Five Finger Rule** to help you decide.

1. Open to a page of the book.
2. Begin reading.
3. **Each time you come to a word you don't know, hold up 1 finger.**
4. After you finish reading the page, check to see how many fingers you are holding up.

Too Easy: 0-1 fingers

Just Right: 2-3 fingers

Too Hard: 4-5 fingers
